Merry Christmas! From all of us at Rushville State Bank, I wish you a happy holiday season and a 2023 filled with good health, peace and prosperity.

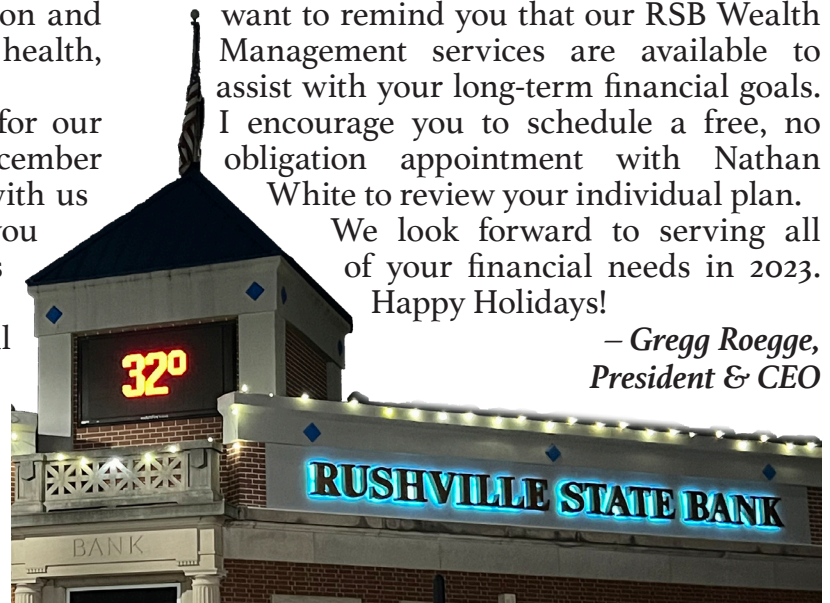
