Rushville State Bank maintains the right to extend or not extend the credit request. As part of the loan application process, you will authorize Rushville State Bank to obtain your consumer credit report from one of the credit bureaus. This will not impact your credit score. All offers are subject to credit approval. No origination fee or application fee. Loan amounts available up to \$12,000. Repayment terms range from 3 to 36 months. This is a fixed installment personal loan. The amount of monthly installment includes Principal and Interest. Interest may vary and depends on your creditworthiness, term, amount of loan, and other factors. Longer-term and larger loans may carry higher Annual Percentage Rate (APR). You will know your Fixed Monthly Installment Fee and interest options upfront. Your Fixed Monthly Installment does not change over the term. There are no other fees or prepayment penalties.

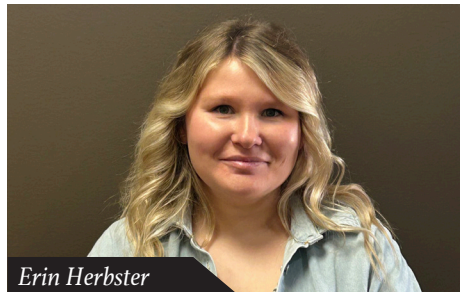
